MOREHOUSE MAGNET SCHOOL – EMERGENCY PLAN FOR JANUARY 2023

Due to record low temperatures, a ruptured sprinkler system in the MPR building at Morehouse Magnet School caused significant damage to all classrooms. Pre-k, Kindergarten, and 1st-grade classes will be relocating temporarily for a duration of approximately 3 months for repairs. We have put forth every effort to ensure that we do what is least disruptive for the children of the Morehouse Parish School System. All students will continue to ride the same buses, and pick-up and drop-off times will remain the same. Kindergarten and 1st-grade teachers and students will move inside Morehouse Magnet School's main building in the junior-high wing. Junior-high teachers and students will relocate to other areas in the school to accommodate Kindergarten and 1st-grade students so they can be near restroom facilities. All Kindergarten through 12th-grade teachers and students will remain at Morehouse Magnet School; however, they may be in different areas.








Pre-k teachers and students will be relocating to the Morehouse Student Services Center at 1607 Martin Luther King South, Bastrop, LA 71220. Mrs. Wendy Coleman will be the designated principal at Morehouse Student Services Center. Pre-k classrooms will be located on the left side of the Morehouse Student Services Center near the restroom facilities. The designated drop-off area for car riders is located on the left side of the building. Parents bringing their children to school late must bring them to the main office located at the front entrance to check them in school. Students riding buses will be dropped off at the front entrance. Please refer to the map below for clarification and further details. Breakfast and lunch services will remain the same. However, students will eat in their classrooms.

The scheduled beginning and dismissal times for school is not anticipated to change. The plan, as of right now, is for all students to resume back to school on Thursday, January 5, 2023. This was made possible because of the incredible efforts of teachers, paraprofessionals, maintenance personnel, and administrators working diligently over the Christmas break for students to return to school on time. Parents will be notified immediately of any changes or updates to the plan. There will be additional help/support during the first couple of days to assist Pre-k teachers, students, and parents with the routines and logistics of the relocations. An open house will be held at Morehouse Magnet School and Morehouse Student Services Center so parents can become familiar with the facilities.
