ADOLESCENT EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM

The adolescent program at Bastrop Addictive Disorders Clinic is a program designed to educate teens on the harmful effects of alcohol and other drug use. Each client is encouraged to explore the consequences of his/her drug/alcohol use. The program consists of a minimum of **twelve (12)** one-hour educational sessions and random drug screening. Group sessions will be held twice a week on Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 3:30 - 4:30 p.m. A clean (negative) drug screen is required for completion of the program.

Upon referral to this program, please call (318) 283-0868 and set up an appointment for screening to determine appropriateness for the program. An adolescent under age sixteen must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian for the screening appointment; however, parents of all children are encouraged to attend this appointment. In some instances, the results of the evaluation may warrant the adolescent being referred elsewhere for more intense treatment.
